One sheet per pet. From the free printable at granite.co/library/guides/pet-vaccination-record

What this is. A summary you keep, so you can answer a kennel, a groomer or a licensing office from one page. It does not prove anything on its own. The document that proves something is the certificate your veterinarian signs.

1. PET IDENTITY

The license tag and the rabies tag are two different tags from two different issuers. Write both numbers, and do not copy one into both lines.
